This product is available only in a Satin finish, which may change the sheen of the previous coating. Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus is generally used no sooner than 6 months to 1 year after initial application of EU30974 Euro X Clear.

M.L. Campbell Euro X products have been formulated for exterior use in varying climates and seasons. Euro X products provide better flexibility, resistance to temperature changes, moisture and UV resistance; however all exterior wood finishes will eventually degrade due to weathering and other natural and environmental conditions. Surface Preparation

Surface must be thoroughly clean, dry and free of contaminants. Hand sand previously coated EU30974 Euro X Clear finish with 280 to 320-grit sandpaper. Mechanical sanders may be too aggressive and break through the previous film. Sand thoroughly but carefully. If applying Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus to bare wood (example: a door or window that has been trimmed or planed during installation) sand bare wood with 180-grit sandpaper prior to application.

Reduction

Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus does not require any reduction before application. However, it may be reduced with small amounts of naptha or minearal spirits if required.

Application Procedure

Spray Application: Apply Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus EU33007 by spray at 5-6 mils. Let dry 6 - 12 hours then sand with 320 grit. Apply 2nd coat Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus EU33007 by spray at 5-6 mils.

Brush Application: If brush application is required, apply Euro X Solvent Borne Maintenance Coat Plus EU33007 at 3 mils. Let dry 6-12 hours (assuming 73F & 60% RH). Apply 2ndcoat Euro X Solvent Borne Maintenance Coat Plus EU33007 at 3 mils. Let dry overnight then sand with 320 grit. Apply 3rdcoat Euro X Solvent Borne Maintenance Coat Plus at 3 mils.

Note: Two to three coats are recommended, depending on conditions and amount of UV exposure. Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus can be applied every 1-2 years at a rate of no more than 3 coats per yearly or bi-yearly application. Full cure time of Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus is 96 hours.

Euro X Solvent Maintenance Coat Plus is also recommended to seal bare wood edges of a door, window, etc. (previously coated with EU30974 Euro X Clear shop applied coating) that has been cut or planed during jobsite installation. Two coats should be applied to seal these edges.
