ADDITIONAL DATA:

For optimum adhesion and application performance, ensure that the temperature and relative humidity are between 15-25°C and 40-60% respectively, at the time of application and for four hours afterward. Before painting a texture ceiling, test for water sensitivity. Many texture ceilings are watersoluble and require a coat of an alkyd paint to stabilize the substrate. If a textured ceiling is watersoluble, use a Alkyd Calcimine Recoater.
