Surface Preparation						
New Work:	New Work: For the best holdout and adhesion, apply over a smooth sanded, primed wood. For primer use W1409 White Undercoater or W35010 Magnalac Primer/Undercoater White					
Old Work:	Strip old finishes completely and remove all contaminants from surface. When surface is dry, sand as required. Finish as new work.					

Reduction

As required. Use C16036 M.L. Campbell Standard Lacquer Thinner.

Application Procedure

Refer to spray equipment suppliers recommendations for lacquer atomizing spray guns, air caps and fluid needles.

Note: Hot spray application is not recommended. If hot spray equipment is used, temperature setting should never be over 110°F (43°C). Stir all products well prior to and during use.

- Store in cool, dry areas in the original sealed containers.
- Do not store around any source of flames or sparks.
- Spills should be cleaned up with non-sparking tools and inert absorbent material.
