formulated to be used on wood substrates when blotching is a problem.

Uses: Amazing Stain is a clear stain base that can be tinted using IC800 colorants, dyes, and

transparent pigments. M.L. Campbell's Distributor Stain Studio's can tint this base to

unlimited stain colors. The recommended tint load is 6% maximum.

New Work: Remove any dirt, grease or other contamination and sand as required.					
Old Work:	Strip old finishes completely and remove all contaminants from the surface. Make sure surface is dry. Finish as new work.

Tinting

Stir or shake before tinting. Amazing Stain can be tinted to any stain color to a maximum tint load of 6%; however, Gilsonite cannot be used as a colorant.

Application Procedure

Amazing Stain should be sprayed using low pressure and low volume. Multiple coats can be applied to achieve desired color.

Recoating

After a minimum of 30 minutes air dry, re-coat stain with a selected finish system of lacquer sealer and finish coat. If stain is used to touch up areas, these touch up spots should also be finished for protection.

Equipment Clean Up

- Use lacquer thinner to clean up all equipment.
- Dispose of dirty solvent and cleaning rags in a safe and approved manner.
- Solvent or lacquer-soaked rags should be stored in water-filled, closed containers prior to disposal.

Dry to Touch: | 5 – 10 minutes

Shelf Life and Storage

- Do not store around any source of flame or sparks.
