

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

The surface to be coated must be free from oil, grease and flash rust. A good quality pre-treatment process if recommend for optimum performance.

Aluminum: chromate, phosphochromate conversion (DIN 50939) or other Cr-free pretreatment

sand blasting or/and iron or zinc phosphatizing

Galvanized steel: chromate (DIN 50939), phosphate or Cr-free pretreatment
